





Four-Bedroom	\$1,040	\$41,600

Working at the minimum wage, a family in the Syracuse region must have 2.0 full-time wage earners — or one full-time earner working 80 hours per week — to afford a two-bedroom apartment at fair market rent. More than half (53%) of renters cannot afford a modest two-bedroom apartment.
